- Protect workers doing warehouse work from the hazards of poorly-designed work equipment and tasks.
- Require worksite evaluation by professionals to identify and address hazards.
- Employers must provide training to all workers handling materials and performing tasks at the warehouse.
- On-site medical office or first aid station must be staffed with medical professionals.
